

Dawn and Kumudu Co-Present the Learning Disability 10 Year Plan



MLMC members have been working with Oxfordshire County Council to co-produce their Learning Disability 10 Year Plan.



MLMC members Dawn and Kumudu were asked to co- present the plan to the Health and Wellbeing Board at County Hall with Sharon Paterson from the Council.



They met with staff from the council to decide who was going to present which section and had a practice run the week before.



On the day of the board meeting, they were shown the room where they would be presenting. There were microphones set up ready for everyone.





Dawn and Kumudu did a fantastic job of copresenting the plan with Sharon and answering questions from the board.

The Health and Wellbeing Board approved the plan.



Everyone was impressed by Dawn and Kumudu's presenting. They were clear and professional.



Dawn said "I felt proud to co-present the plan, it was good.
It's important to be included in decisions which affect us, we shouldn't be left out".



Kumudu said "It's important that people with lived experience are co-producing the plan because we understand how challenging it is to live with learning disabilities. I felt empowered and proud to present the plan"



Champions August 2025: Have Your Say!





At the end of January our Champion Ady, had a 'life-changing' opportunity.



He went to the Glastonbury Music Festival in Somerset to talk on a politics panel on the Leftfield Stage.



Ady went to speak about the government's changes to benefits and the big worries this had caused disabled people.



Ady told the crowd of hundreds "people are struggling, and it feels like the government are trying to trick them into losing their money".



He got to speak on stage at the same time as other important voices, like Manchester mayor Andy Burnham.



The pressure from Ady and other disabled groups and people meant the government dropped some changes to benefits.



Champions will continue to fight though, so people have the support they need to live good lives.

Staying Safe on Social Media





Some MLMC members have been asking about safety when using social media.



Social media like TikTok, Facebook, Instagram and SnapChat let you talk to people online and see things they share.



Your social media account includes personal information about you that you should keep safe.



Hide your location on social media and don't share your phone number, address or postcode online.



You should only add people you know.



A stranger online can be a risk, not everybody is who they say they are on social media.



Be careful what you post online, it might be seen by lots of people not just your friends.



Think about how what you post may make people feel.



If you feel unsafe, are being asked to do something you don't want to, or are experiencing abuse come offline.



Remember you are in control of who you talk to online, block any abusive people and report it.



Talk to someone you trust like a support worker, friend or family member who can help you deal with what is happening.



If you are experiencing abuse online contact the police and keep any evidence to show them.




