Oxford Climate Awards





We are very happy that in September MLMC won the Oxford Climate Award 2025 for it's brilliant Travel Buddy Scheme!



The Travel Buddy Scheme helps the environment as Travel Buddies teach people how to travel on public transport or get to places by walking or wheeling.



Choosing not to travel by car if we can, means less pollution from harmful gases goes into the air which heat up our planet.



Travel Buddies Jordan and Hayley went to a ceremony at the Oxford Town Hall to meet the other finalists and to find out who had won.



Jordan said he is 'very proud' that MLMC won and when asked what's next, Hayley said 'training even more people to travel by bus so they don't need to get taxis'.

Kyle needed to learn how to get to his new training placements that were starting in September.

She has been meeting Amy for weekly travel training sessions so that Amy can practise using good road safety skills when she is out on a journey.



Nicola taught Amy how important it is to put phones away and to stay focused and aware especially when crossing roads.

Positive Voices is a national conference which self advocacy groups like My Life My Choice from across the country attend.



In the morning people could ask health experts about the big health issues learning disabled people face.

The panel were not sure, but said we should work together to help people speak up about their health.

Gig Buddies visited Oxford Speedway to watch motorbike racing.




Some people were really close to track and got sprayed with dirt!


